You will receive additional hours of hands-on, practical applications of law enforcement techniques and experience as well as a number of certifications not typically provided in a basic POST approved course.

Location and Information

The Law Enforcement Training Institute is located in the Warren E. Hearnese Center on the campus of the University of Missouri in Columbia, Missouri.

Established in 1839, the University of Missouri-Columbia, is the oldest state university west of the Mississippi River, and is the largest of the four campuses of the University of Missouri System. Other campuses are located in St. Louis, Kansas City, and Rolla.

The Hearnese Center, the equivalent of a seven story building, is spread over four and one half acres, and is easily accessible from Interstate 70 or U.S. 63. Located just east of Memorial Stadium, at the intersection of Providence Road and Highway 740 (Stadium Boulevard), the Hearnese Center affords our students easy access and ample parking.

Special lodging rates are usually available for students from outside the Columbia area. Contact the Law Enforcement Training Institute for lodging information.

Registration

Tuition for the Class A program is \$3,500. Tuition is covered by *Training/Continuing Education Account Agreements* and may be paid for from this fund if monies are available. The fee includes all texts, notebooks, two sets of Academy uniforms required for the course, defensive tactics clothing, parking permit, a graduation certificate upon completion, and Continuing Education Units (CEUs).
