This one-day course is designed for anyone tasked with the responsibility of investigating crime scenes. This introductory crime scene investigation course teaches the fundamentals and procedures of investigating a wide variety of crime scenes. Emphasis will be placed on detecting, documenting and collecting evidence.

Topics covered will include:

- Searching for evidence
- · Use of alternate light sources
- · Use of chemical evidence reagents
- Latent fingerprint evidence processing
- Basic photography
- Evidence collection
- Documenting evidence

This course includes classroom discussion of the related topics.

Instructor: Travis Witt. Travis began his career as a police officer for the City of Bourbon, Missouri. He later transferred to the Crawford County, Missouri, Sheriff's Department where he rose to the rank of Lieutenant in just three short years. Travis was in command of the Jail Division and Detective Bureau while at the Sheriff's Department. Travis then went to work for the City of Chesterfield, Missouri, and had special assignments on Crisis Intervention Team and the Greater St. Louis Major Case Squad. Travis later went to work for the City of Placentia, California, retiring from there in 2012. Travis is the E-Learning Coordinator for the Law Enforcement Training Institute as well as a Faculty Instructor. He holds instructor certifications and licenses in a variety of topics including: Firearms, Defensive Tactics, and Terrorism.
